Dishing It Up! is a deliciously fun game with 200 dishes from around the world. Guess your friends' favorite foods in a variety of intriguing situations and hilarious hypotheticals. Win the game and be crowned First-Rate Foodie.

MISE EN PLACE! - GAME SETUP

1. Remove the BLANK CARDS at the end of each colored deck and set aside.
2. Shuffle the QUESTION CARDS (red) + WILD CARDS (end of deck) together and place them face down in the center of the playing area.
3. Shuffle the DISH CARDS (orange) and deal 7 cards to each player. Place several tall stacks of the remaining Dish Cards face down in the center of the playing area for easy replenishment.
4. Shuffle the CONDIMENT CARDS (white) and deal 2 cards to each player. Players can look at them, but keep them face down to the side.
5. Make a Leftover Pile for discards by flipping over the top of the box—if you run out of Dish Cards during the course of play, simply shuffle the leftovers to “reheat” the cards.

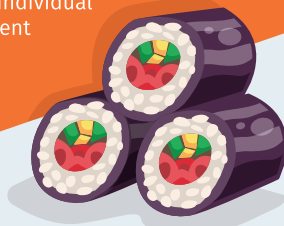
PROVECHO! - GAME PLAY

1. Choose a player who will be the Foodie for the first round. The Foodie kicks things off by drawing a Question Card and reading the question, statement, or fill-in-the-blank.
2. All other players respond by serving up 1 Dish Card from their hand (face down) that they think the Foodie will be most likely to choose as their favorite answer.
3. The Foodie then shuffles the selections, flips them over, and reads them aloud. If anyone chooses to play a Condiment Card or a Wild Card, this is the time! (See the next page for details.)
4. After taking into consideration any Condiment or Wild Cards that have been played, the Foodie chooses their favorite answer as the winning dish.
5. The player whose dish is chosen wins the round and places their winning Dish Card face up next to them to keep score. The rest of the Dish Cards go straight to the Leftover Pile.
6. All players (except the Foodie) replenish their hand with 1 Dish Card.
7. Play continues clockwise.



POURING IT ON! - CONDIMENT CARDS

1. During each round, after all the Dish Cards have been served up and read aloud by the Foodie, any player (except the Foodie) has the chance to add one of their Condiment Cards. More than one player can play a Condiment Card in a round.
2. To play your Condiment Card, place it face up on top of any single Dish Card. It can be played to enhance your own Dish Card or to "ruin" another player's.
3. The Foodie must take the added condiment into consideration when choosing their favorite answer.
4. If the Dish Card + Condiment Card pair is chosen as the winner, each card is kept by its respective player and counts toward their individual score. If the Dish Card + Condiment Card were played by the same player, that player keeps both cards and wins 2 points!



WILD MUSHROOMS! - WILD CARDS

There are 14 Wild Cards that will pop up in the Question Card deck. Read and carefully follow the instructions on the card. Wild Cards indicate a change in the usual rules and are a fun opportunity for the game to shift dramatically. Wild Cards might instruct you on a change in game play for the CURRENT round or to hold onto for a strategic move in a later round. Once a Wild Card is played it must be discarded.

FIRST-RATE FOODIE AWARD! - WINNING THE GAME

A player is declared the First-Rate Foodie when they collect 7 winning Dish Cards. Into fast food? Set the winning number to 5 for a shorter game. Hungry for more? Set the winning number to 10 for an epic event.



IN THE WEEDS! - IN CASE OF A TIE GAME

To break a tie, tied players serve up a final Dish Card from their hand. The dish originating from the farthest country or region wins! Example: Player 1 puts down Lasagna, Player 2 puts down Samosas. If you're playing in the United States, Player 2's Samosas (India) wins the game. If you're playing in Thailand, Player 1's Lasagna (Italy) wins!

CLEAN PLATES! - BLANK CARDS

Write down your foodie favorites on the blank Question, Dish, and Condiment Cards provided. Add them to the appropriate stacks to make the game your own!
